This simple, quick check-list is designed to determine if your cat may have any changes that might be indicative of the presence of arthritis or joint pain.

Does your cat ever show signs of stiffness?

Does your cat have a poor coat? Spend less time grooming?			
Does your cat spend less time grooming than before?			
Overall is your cat less agile?			
Does your cat show signs of lameness or limping?			
Does your cat have more accidents outside the litter tray?			
Does your cat have difficulty getting in or out of the cat flap?			
Does your cat have difficulty going up or down stairs?
